Dear friends, dear Hasher friends,

Sorry for the long delay in updating you concerning our activities to help victims of Tsunami.

Due to your generosity we were able to collect EUR 9.699,50 which we are extremely happy about and like to thank you so much.

Apart from the stud bulls project which did not materialize because of conflicts among the farmers all investments worked out well. Apart from LKR 10.000 (approx. EUR 80.-) which was paid as an advance for the bulls and which we consequently had to write off no money was lost. The balance money of LKR 115.000 was re-allocated for urgent land clearing for families returning to their land from the refugee camps.

Attached you find the accounts for our involvement in

- BATTICALOA with the Burgher Association (which we abandoned for various reasons, nevertheless, the little money we spent there was of help for some people especially under humanitarian reasons and to put some people back on their feet job wise).
- KOMARI where we set up 18 transitional houses and helped to establish a bakery which has become a landmark providing people and kids with decent bread and tasty tidbits and cake. We are winding up our activities now. The progress is quite impressive and our cooperation with the US based NGO *Community Focused Disaster Response (CFDR)* was very encouraging and satisfying as we really achieved our main goal: that the funds get to the people without unnecessary loss. Now a number of big NGOs has taken over but we can be proud of having done our share in the hour of need.

The balance money we decided to invest into a project in the Galle area down south for the construction of an orphanage for children who lost their parents in the tsunami disaster. The father of Dinar's best friend from school days has donated a rather big piece of land for this purpose. She lives in California and is organizing funds from that end while her sister does the same in Sri Lanka. The laying of the foundation stone took place in mid April and we will visit the place when her friend comes to Colombo in July. We have seen photo-graphs and from the set-up we can be sure about the project.

In order not to overload the attachment we don't send too many photos. Should you however like to see more feel free to send us an e-mail and we will provide you with more pictures. We will also keep you informed in word and picture about the orphanage in Galle.
