

# F.U.K. Full Moon H3 atterned in Paisley

Full Moon Interhash Weekend away trip/1 day event Mar 30-Apr 1 2007

In conjunction with North of the Border Full Moon H3, for 2007 the First UK Full Moon H3 are visiting the sacred site of Howwood. This is not the How Wood, near St Albans, Hertfordshire, but the more colourful one on the outskirts of Paisley, near Glasgow in Scotland.

## What are we going to do:

The event is to be held in and around Glasgow, on the weekend of the Full Moon 30<sup>th</sup> March-1<sup>st</sup> April 2007. (This is the weekend before Easter). There will be a moderate contingent of Scottish and visiting hashers for Friday and Saturday, before the large turnout 1 day event on the Sunday. The timetable will look something like this:

### Friday.

18.00 Meet up at Bon Accord PH. 153 North Street, Glasgow, G3 7DA. This is a many time winner of Glasgow Camra pub of the year, serving very many good real ales.  
20.00 ish Pubcrawl round Glasgow hared by Hughie Blaargh, visiting the varied collection of hostilities that Scotland's first city has to offer.  
22.00 Return to Bon Accord to collect the stragglers (and at least one GM) who have just arrived on the evening flights from the 'sarf.  
23.00ish Time for a few more beers, and a Curry.

### Saturday

07.30 onwards DIY Breakfast at Edward G Wylie PH (Wetherspoons). Bothwell Street  
11.00 meet at Central train station. Drop any Hash bags in Car.  
11.15 Catch Hash Train to the start of the Howwood A-B trail. Trail will be assisted by MASS (Mid Argyll Swamp Skiers) who only run on the fifth Saturday of the month! We will visit the sacred town, and sing a song (or two.) Ending up in a local pub where lunch will be provided, amongst the Full Moon Revelry. Alternative Short cut trail taking in more pubs.  
Later: Visit the many Patterned streets of Paisley, and a few Full Moon friendly pubs  
More later: Return on hash Train for buffet, more beer and an even later Curry at night in an award winning Indian Restaurant

### Sunday

Am Visit local Wetherspoons for Breakfast, tbc,(Henglers Circus or Counting House)  
11.15 A one day event with local hashes. Trail will encompass the city and parks of Glasgow, and will have long and short trails. Probably start from Bon Accord - or at least from George Square and ending at Bon Accord. Bag drop. Drink and hash party the afternoon away.  
Sunday evening: Party on or catch trains and planes back home (Main crowd will diminish after 16.00-17.00 ish although the FUKFMH3 stalwarts will be staying over until Monday.

## Where are you going to stay?

There are two choices of accommodation that you will need to book.

**Either** stay at the Glasgow Globetrotters Hostel, 56 Berkeley Street – Glasgow G3 7DS <http://www.glasgowhostels.co.uk/prices.html> Hostel prices between £8 and £17.50 per person/per night in dorms, quad, and twin rooms. £1 off with voucher that you pick up at reception. When booking please suffix your name with H3. Please note that the North Lodge Hostel has now closed.

**Or** at the Premier Travel Inn Charing X (0870 990 6312), 10 Elmbank Gardens, Glasgow, G2 4PP. This is 200m across the road from the Bon Accord but there are motorway bridges involved. This costs £56 for a room for a night. Book at <http://www.premiertravelinn.com>
